If the software is called XYZ then the following might be the questions you would ask.
 _Are you as a using XYZ software on a regular basis?
 _What parts of the software are you using?
 _Have them walk you through the processes they do to get the information into and out of the program.
 _What do they like about the software?
 _What do they dislike about the software?
 _What problems does the software solve for the company?
 _Would they buy the program if they were starting from scratch with a new program?
_What type of support has the vendor given them? * In the process of implementing the software. * Once the software was up and running.
 _How long did it take from the day they installed the software until it was up and running and they felt comfortable with it?
_What reports and other information do the managers us to better manage your organization.
 _Would they be willing to let you come to their location and see how they use the software? (You need to make at least one visit to a company using the software.)
